

REGATTA RALLY 2026

Event Terms & Conditions

Event Dates: November 2–7, 2026

Location: The Regatta on Grand, 11601 US Hwy 59, Grove, Oklahoma 74344

Operator: WSRR LLC d/b/a The Regatta on Grand ("The Regatta")

These Event Terms & Conditions ("Rally Terms") apply specifically to registration for and participation in the Regatta Rally 2026 ("Rally").

By registering for the Rally, the person making the reservation acknowledges and agrees to these Rally Terms. These Rally Terms are in addition to The Regatta on Grand's general Terms & Conditions. If these Rally Terms conflict with the general Terms & Conditions regarding the Rally, these Rally Terms will control.

1. Eligibility

The Regatta Rally is an adults-only event. All participants must be **21 years of age or older** as of the first day of the Rally.

Each participant may also be required to satisfy eligibility, identification, physical, safety, weight, licensing, or other requirements established by third-party activity providers.

2. Registration & Payment

Full payment is required at the time of booking.

A Rally registration is not confirmed until required payment has been successfully processed.

The Rally registration is sold as a bundled event package. Individual meals, activities, excursions, entertainment, transportation services, amenities, or other components are not separately priced and have no individual refundable or cash value.

3. Nonrefundable Registration

ALL REGATTA RALLY REGISTRATIONS ARE FINAL AND NONREFUNDABLE.

Due to advance planning, vendor commitments, reservations, staffing, food preparation, merchandise, transportation arrangements, and other costs associated with producing the Rally, no refunds or travel credits will be issued when a participant cancels or is unable to attend.

This policy applies regardless of the participant's reason for cancellation or inability to attend, except where otherwise required by law.

The standard cancellation policy applicable to ordinary stays at The Regatta on Grand does not apply to Rally registrations.

Participants are strongly encouraged to consider travel insurance that may provide coverage for unforeseen circumstances preventing attendance.

4. Cancellation of the Entire Rally

If The Regatta cancels the **Regatta Rally in its entirety for any reason**, participants will receive a full refund of amounts paid directly to The Regatta for their Rally registration.

The Regatta is not responsible for reimbursing participants for expenses paid to third parties in connection with attending the Rally, including but not limited to fuel, airfare, rental vehicles, RV expenses, lodging before or after the Rally, travel arrangements, or other incidental expenses, except where otherwise required by law.

Cancellation, modification, substitution, postponement, or unavailability of one or more individual Rally components does not constitute cancellation of the Rally.

5. Meaning of “All-Inclusive”

For purposes of the Regatta Rally, **“all-inclusive” means the scheduled meals, scheduled excursions and activities, and designated transportation specifically identified as included in the official Rally itinerary.**

“All-inclusive” does not mean unlimited food, beverages, alcohol, activities, excursions, transportation, restaurant dining, or other resort services.

Participants must attend included meals, activities, excursions, and transportation at their designated dates and times to receive those inclusions.

6. Included Meals

Registration includes the meals specifically identified as included on the official Rally itinerary.

Meals may include predetermined menus, limited menus, buffet or family-style service, or multi-course dining experiences depending upon the scheduled meal or event.

Included meals are available only during their designated service periods. Participants who miss an included meal may not redeem it at another time, exchange it for restaurant credit, apply its value toward another food or beverage purchase, or receive a refund.

Participants should notify The Regatta in advance of known food allergies or dietary restrictions. The Regatta will make reasonable efforts to accommodate disclosed dietary needs but cannot guarantee an allergen-free environment or that every dietary request can be accommodated.

7. On-Site Restaurant Dining

The Regatta's on-site restaurants may be available to Rally participants during their normal operating hours.

Food and beverages ordered outside of the meals specifically included in the official Rally itinerary are **not included in the Rally registration price** and are the participant's financial responsibility.

8. Alcoholic Beverages

Alcoholic beverages are not included in Rally registration unless expressly identified as part of a scheduled Rally experience, including the Paint & Sip experience and Wine Dinner.

All other alcoholic beverages are the participant's responsibility.

Alcohol service is subject to applicable law and The Regatta's and its vendors' responsible-service policies. The Regatta and its vendors reserve the right to refuse alcohol service when appropriate.

9. Optional Gift Card Promotion

Participants may have the opportunity to preload funds onto a Regatta gift card for additional food and beverage purchases during the Rally.

Where offered, The Regatta will provide a promotional match equal to 50% of the qualifying amount purchased, subject to the specific terms, limits, restrictions, and conditions disclosed for that promotion.

The gift card program is optional and separate from Rally registration.

10. Scheduled Activities & Excursions

Rally registration includes participation in the activities and excursions identified as included on the official Rally itinerary.

Activities and excursions are offered only at their scheduled dates and times.

Participants are responsible for arriving at designated meeting and departure locations by the communicated time.

An included activity or excursion cannot be individually rescheduled, transferred to another date or time, or redeemed at a participant's convenience.

If a participant misses, declines, arrives too late for, or otherwise chooses not to participate in an included activity or excursion, no refund, credit, replacement activity, or cash value will be provided.

11. Transportation

The Regatta will provide transportation between the resort and designated off-site Rally activities at scheduled departure and return times communicated to participants.

Included transportation is provided solely in connection with the official Rally itinerary.

Included transportation is not an on-demand shuttle, taxi, rideshare, or personal transportation service.

Participants must be present at the designated departure location at the scheduled departure time. Transportation may depart as scheduled without participants who are late.

Participants who miss scheduled transportation are responsible for arranging and paying for alternative transportation if they choose to do so.

The Regatta is not obligated to provide private or additional transportation to accommodate a participant who misses a scheduled departure, wishes to leave an activity early, wishes to remain at an activity longer, or wishes to participate at a different date or time.

12. Itinerary, Activity & Schedule Changes

The official Rally itinerary represents The Regatta's planned schedule but is subject to change.

Activities, excursions, meals, menus, entertainment, vendors, transportation schedules, locations, and event times may be modified, delayed, substituted, rescheduled, or canceled due to weather, safety considerations, vendor availability, mechanical issues, transportation conditions, operational needs, or other circumstances outside The Regatta's reasonable control.

When an included activity cannot take place as planned, The Regatta will make reasonable efforts to provide an alternative activity or experience when feasible. The Regatta cannot guarantee that a replacement will be identical or have an equivalent retail or monetary value.

Changes, substitutions, delays, or cancellations affecting individual portions of the Rally do not constitute cancellation of the Rally and do not entitle participants to a full or partial refund.

13. Third-Party Activity Providers

Certain Rally activities and excursions are operated or provided by independent third-party businesses.

Third-party providers may establish their own participation requirements, safety rules, restrictions, waivers, releases, and other conditions.

Participants agree to comply with applicable requirements of third-party providers.

Participation in certain activities may require execution of an additional waiver, release, acknowledgment, or safety agreement required by the provider.

A participant who refuses or fails to satisfy a provider's participation requirements or execute a required provider agreement may be unable to participate in that activity. Such inability to participate does not entitle the participant to a refund, credit, replacement activity, or cash value.

14. Participant Waiver & Release

Every Rally participant must individually execute The Regatta Rally Participant Waiver, Release & Assumption of Risk before participating in the Rally.

Acceptance of these Rally Terms by the person making the reservation does not substitute for the individual Participant Waiver required from each attendee.

Execution of the Participant Waiver is a condition of participation in the Rally. Participants who decline to execute the required waiver will not be permitted to participate in Rally activities and will not be entitled to a refund or credit.

15. Participant Conduct & Safety

Participants must comply with reasonable instructions provided by The Regatta, its employees, transportation providers, activity providers, and other Rally vendors.

The Regatta reserves the right to deny participation in an activity or remove a participant from an activity or the Rally when The Regatta reasonably determines that the participant's behavior presents a safety risk, substantially disrupts the event, threatens or harasses another person, damages property, violates applicable law or event rules, violates a third-party provider's requirements, or creates an unreasonable risk to the participant or others.

Removal resulting from participant misconduct does not entitle the participant to a refund.

16. Personal Responsibility

Participation in individual Rally activities is voluntary.

Participants are responsible for evaluating whether they are physically and otherwise capable of safely participating in an activity and for communicating relevant limitations directly to an activity provider when appropriate.

Participants may decline to participate in any activity. Choosing not to participate does not entitle the participant to a refund or credit.

17. Weather

The Rally includes indoor and outdoor activities and will generally proceed despite ordinary weather conditions.

Weather may require changes to the itinerary or the modification, postponement, substitution, relocation, or cancellation of individual activities.

Such changes do not constitute cancellation of the Rally and do not entitle participants to a refund.

18. Photography & Video

Photography and video recording may occur throughout the Rally for promotional, marketing, social media, advertising, and archival purposes.

Participants who do not wish to be prominently or individually featured in promotional materials should notify The Regatta in writing before the Rally and make reasonable efforts to identify themselves to event staff or photographers when requested.

Participants acknowledge that The Regatta may not be able to prevent incidental appearance in crowd shots, backgrounds, or general documentation of the event.

19. Personal Property

Participants remain responsible for their RVs, vehicles, personal belongings, valuables, equipment, and other property throughout the Rally.

Participants are encouraged to appropriately secure valuable property.

20. Relationship to General Resort Terms

The Regatta on Grand's general Terms & Conditions and resort rules continue to apply during the Rally except where specifically modified by these Rally Terms.

If there is a conflict regarding Rally registration, cancellation, inclusions, activities, scheduling, transportation, or participation, these Rally Terms will control.

21. Governing Law & Dispute Resolution

These Rally Terms shall be governed by the laws of the State of Oklahoma.

Any dispute arising out of or relating to Rally registration or these Rally Terms shall be subject to the dispute-resolution provisions contained in The Regatta on Grand's general Terms & Conditions, to the extent enforceable under applicable law.

22. Severability

If any provision of these Rally Terms is determined to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall remain in effect to the fullest extent permitted by law.

23. Electronic Acceptance

Participants may receive and accept these Rally Terms electronically. Electronic acceptance is intended to have the same effect as a handwritten acknowledgment to the extent permitted by applicable law.

24. Acknowledgment

By completing registration, the person making the reservation acknowledges that they:

- have read and understand these Rally Terms;
- understand that Rally registrations are nonrefundable;
- understand what is and is not included in the all-inclusive Rally package;
- understand that schedules, activities, excursions, meals, and vendors may change;
- understand that every participant must separately execute the required Participant Waiver; and
- agree to these Rally Terms.
